The John T. Schroeder Memorial Scholarship Fund was established as a tribute to

John T. Schroeder

On September 11, 2001, John, 31, was employed as a NASDAQ stock trader with Fred Alger Management. John was reportedly at a breakfast meeting with members of his former firm [Harvey Young Yurman, Inc.] in Windows on the World restaurant atop the World Trade Center when the first hijacked plane struck. He had been with Fred Alger, on the 93rd floor of the North Tower only since July 2001.

John T. Schroeder, who helped bring Princeton University to its first NCAA National Lacrosse Championship in 1992, was an accomplished athlete who continued to play lacrosse and touch football throughout his adult life. According to his friends, he was the “...nicest, most generous guy you could meet”.

Besides playing football and lacrosse at Princeton, Schroeder was active in Cap & Gown and the 21 Club and according to his Classmates, John was known for “...his great sense of humor”.

Schroeder also played football and lacrosse at St. Anthony’s High School in Huntington Station where he graduated in 1988. He moved to Hoboken, N.J., in 1993, but kept in close touch with his mother Nonie until she died in 1997, his brother, Matthew, his sisters Amy, and Erin, and his father Jack.

The Schroeder Family’s goal is to award up to three (3) scholarships annually to seniors who are graduating from High Schools in Nassau or Suffolk County, NY. The graduating students should demonstrate love for family, and excellence in academics and athletics. Additionally they should demonstrate selflessness, outstanding character and a strong work ethic, along with involvement in extracurricular activities and community service.
